- ▶ Building Photographs



Why We Do Inventories

- ▶ Best way to understand the total makeup of a downtown/uptown district
- ▶ Very helpful for reporting statistics
- ▶ Key component of business recruitment
- ▶ Valuable information for attracting developers
- ▶ Powerful tool to sell your program



Why We Do Inventories

➔ SAVES TIME!!!





Property Inventory

- Address
- Tax map parcel ID number, with hyperlink to county tax record
- Square footage per floor
- Use per floor/space, note if any are vacant
- Tax value broken out by land and buildings
- Acreage



Property Inventory

- Owner's name, address, phone number, and email
- Management company contact info if applicable
- # of storefronts
- Historic status (in NR and/or local historic district, contributing or non contributing)



Business Inventory

- Address
- Business name
- Business phone number
- Square feet of space
- Type of use (retail, rest., office, service)
- Annual rent per square foot



Business Inventory

- ▶ Business website and social media sites with hyperlinks to each
- ▶ Year opened
- ▶ Number of full-time and part-time employees
- ▶ Business owner's name, email, and cell-phone number



Market Snapshot

- ▶ A service of the NC Main Street staff!
 - ▶ Take advantage of this!
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Parking Inventory

- # of on-street parking spaces and location (block, side of block)
- # of spaces in public parking lots
- # of spaces in private parking lots



Parking Inventory

- Break down spaces in lots by striped lots and un-striped lots, with an explanation of how the # of spaces in unstriped lots were figured (150 spaces/acre)



Residential Inventory

- ▶ # of units
- ▶ Type of unit (rental vs condo)
- ▶ Rent per sf for apartments
- ▶ Hotel and motel rooms, Air BNBs
- ▶ Year developed
- ▶ Links to any websites for the above units
 - ▶ Note – owner and/or management information would be found on the Building Inventory, can duplicate here if helpful



Building Photograph Inventory

- ▶ File for each building
- ▶ Photo of each façade
- ▶ Photo of significant architectural elements



Building Photograph Inventory

- ▶ Representative photos of interior
- ▶ Label the above photos with the year
- ▶ Historic photos
